

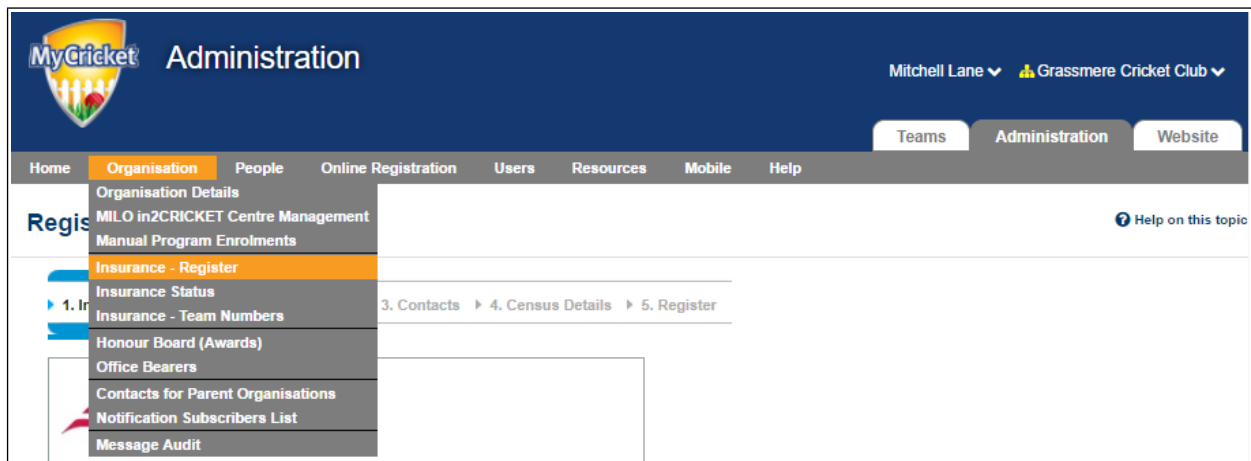
How to Register for Insurance and receive a Certificate of Currency

The renewal date for the program is 30 June, with the program renewing for another year on 30 June the following year.

Clubs can now pay their insurance premiums online immediately following completion of their MyCricket registration and the JLT Sport risk management module.

1. Log on to MyCricket > MODE: Administration > MENU: Organisation > Insurance – Register



2. Review the NCRPP Insurance Registrations introduction

3. Confirm your club's organisation details

4. Confirm the key contact who should receive communications from JLT and your State and Territory Association, you can have multiple contacts as long as they are on the MyCricket system with an active record. This is also the list of contacts who will receive the insurance invoice from JLT Sport.

5. Estimate the number of teams you will have compete under your association. For clubs who compete across multiple associations you will need choose each association via the 'select association' option and enter in each team. If you do not happen to field a team in an association that is linked to you please check the tick box 'we don't not field team in this association'

6. Once you have completed the club details process, you will then be directed to the JLT Sport website to complete the risk management module.

7. You will enter the payment System and your insurance invoice will then become available. You have the option of paying the invoice online immediately, or paying at a later date. The invoice lists the various payment methods.

Once your invoice is paid, your insurance Certificate of Currency becomes available to be printed and/or emailed.

Clubs pay on a per team basis. The system will be populated with your team numbers (senior/veteran and junior) from the previous season.

This season only Cricket Queensland administrators can edit these numbers if required. If you believe your team numbers are not accurate, please contact Cricket Queensland

National Club Risk Protection Programme (NCRPP)

Insurance & Risk Protection - Make sure you're registered!

JLT Sport arranges the Insurance and Risk Protection scheme for cricket members throughout Australia. This scheme is called the National Club Risk Protection Programme (NCRPP). It is designed to save clubs and associations time, effort, and money and provide enhanced cover and services for the cricket community.

Insurance registration is available through MyCricket each season as of 1 July.

What is Covered?

JLT Sport arranges the Insurance and Risk Protection scheme for cricket members throughout Australia. This scheme is called the National Club Risk Protection Programme. It provides cricket members and clubs with Public Liability, Club Management Liability and Personal Accident cover.

Am I covered?

The fastest way to confirm cover, is to register your club for this season via MyCricket and to complete JLT Sport's Online Risk Management Module. This will mean that any participant claims are processed smoothly.

It's that simple!

MyCricket + JLT Sport Risk Management = Registered and Covered

Certificate of Currency

A Certificate of Currency demonstrates your club has Public Liability Insurance Cover. Some Councils ask for a copy of your Certificate before allowing access to grounds. To unlock and download your Certificate, just register your club.

Claims and reimbursement

Reimbursement for Personal Accident Claims can only occur after your club's registration has been confirmed via MyCricket. JLT staff will check your club's registration status before processing any claims.
