Claiming a Super Bonus Point in Saturday One Dayers and Sunday 50 Over Matches

Attention All Secretaries and Delegates 14-Dec-2018

You will recall that this season a Super Bonus Point has been introduced for teams who win within 20 overs in Saturday 35 over matches and for teams who win within 30 overs in Sunday 50 Over matches.

Several times recently mistakes have been made entering the Super Bonus Point for limited over matches on Saturdays and Sundays.

If a Super Bonus Point is claimed in any game it must be entered in MyCricket as a result like the red ringed section in the picture below.
